SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The Praying Savior – John 17

The Lessons from Jesus' Prayer – Appreciating the Precious Promise of God's Preservation - John 17:11-12

1. Discuss and explain what is meant by Jesus being “no long in the world” while believers are said to yet be “in the world”. What does this mean for you on a daily basis?
2. If we are “in” or subject to the influences of the world, then what is the only sure foundation for salvation? Explain why this is so.
3. How is the following statement adequate in conveying the truth of eternal security – “Once saved always saved.” Why or why not?
4. Which person are said to “secure” or kept the believer? Are there any passages of Scripture that suggest that a believer is “kept” by his own works?
5. What is the provision of being kept in the name of God?
6. What is the provision of being kept for the purpose of being One with other believers and with God?
