### **R<sub>2</sub>L – Resolved to Live: Living Life Without Regrets (Part 2)**

Acts 20:17-21

*17 From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called to him the elders of the church. 18 And when they had come to him, he said to them, “You yourselves know, from the first day that I set foot in Asia, how I was with you the whole time, 19 serving the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials which came upon me through the plots of the Jews; 20 how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you publicly and from house to house, 21 solemnly testifying to both Jews and Greeks of repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.*

Discussion Questions:

1. In what ways are you to be involved in biblical teaching? What are some ways in which you might better be involved and engaged in biblical teaching?
2. How is the following statement a true reflection of biblical truth? *“We are not truly committed to the Word of God if we are not rehearsing the truths of God.”* What Scriptures support this?
3. How might you encourage yourself or others to develop the same compulsion of Paul to share Christ with others?
4. What are some of the excuses you have used or have heard from others that keeps us from living by the will and word of God, calling people to repentance and faith?
